Lesson Information

Duration: Private drum lessons are offered in both one hour and thirty minute increments. One hour lessons are recommended for intermediate to advanced students, while half hour lessons help beginning students to avoid frustration and eventual burnout.

Equipment: Students will be responsible for bringing all necessary equipment (i.e. drumsticks, brushes, hearing protection, a folder or binder, USB thumb drive), as well as any educational materials currently being studied to each lesson (i.e. books, CD's, MP3's, videos). Most of the study material will be provided by the instructor (including worksheets and music in hard copy or digital formats), but occasionally the need for students to purchase specific educational materials will arise. KDR provides new monthly students with their first pair of drumsticks.

Strategy: Each new student will be evaluated to determine their current skill level and an individualized lesson plan will be created across multiple disciplines (i.e. reading, writing, rudiments, coordination, timekeeping, meter, style development, etc.). Benchmarks will be set based on goals provided in the goal planning worksheet, as well as current requirements of any attended institution(s) [if applicable]. All lesson plans seek to satisfy the three modalities of learning (auditory, visual, and kinesthetic) in order to ensure a complete understanding of the material being studied.

Expectations: Instructor expectations for students are simple. Practice the assigned lesson(s), come prepared with all necessary materials, and most importantly have fun learning and growing as a musician.
